

THE WORLD'S LARGEST INTEGRATED TEXTILE PARK OPENS AT GDIZ

GDIZ will host the largest integrated textile industrial complex, covering everything from spinning to garment manufacturing, including weaving, knitting, and dyeing.

Spanning 50 hectares, this park comprises three integrated units that will process 40,000 tons per year, accounting for 12.7% of the total annual cotton fiber produced in Benin. GDIZ Textile Park will generate over 20,000 direct jobs, providing significant opportunities for the youth of Benin.

GDIZ IS DEDICATED TO SPEARHEAD DIGITISATION OF AGRICULTURE IN BENIN



Agricultural digitisation refers to the use of digital technologies in farming and related activities. The digital transformation of agriculture not only enhances agricultural efficiency but also contributes to increased productivity by using optimal resources, ensuring sustainability throughout the value chain.

The benefits of connected devices and other digital technologies in agriculture are substantial. Technologies such as sensors and Internet of Things (IoT) provide farmers with more accurate information for timely decision-making. Farmers cultivating in rain-dependent areas gain precise insights into soil moisture and actual water needs, while those exposed to crop failures receive information on weather, insects, pests, etc. This enables farmers to practice precision agriculture with highly optimised resources. The use of digital tools by farmers facilitates traceability, price attractiveness, and sustainability in the supply chain.

As a key player in the digitisation of agriculture in Benin, SIPI-BENIN S.A. has developed a digital application named "Arise Farmer Information System (AFIS)". This platform records details of fields and crops, agricultural activities, warehouses, potable water availability, etc. By December 2023, over 117,663 farmers from various regions of Benin have already been registered. The creation and updating of this digital database will speed up the sustainable development of agriculture in Benin. SIPI-BENIN S.A. has set up a system for registering other farmers in Benin. Additionally, the company will develop new digital tools to promote sustainable production and the supply of various commercial crops in Benin, such as cotton, cashew nuts, shea, and pineapples.

NEW WORKING SESSION WITH MINISTER OF STATE, MR. ABDOULAYE BIO TCHANÉ AT GDIZ

On Friday, December 8, 2023, GDIZ had the honour of welcoming Mr. Abdoulaye Bio Tchané, Benin's Minister of State for Development and Government Action Coordination, and his delegation at GDIZ for a new working session with the Zone's leaders.

Several topics were on the agenda, including the presentation of the development work for the second phase, the installation of approved investors, the strengthening of security measures, and the starting of the Residential Zone work.

The Minister announced an imminent study to be carried out by his office for the development of healthcare centers, schools, and housing. This study will be shared with GDIZ to support the development of the Zone.

The Minister also highlighted the need for the development of training centers and incubators to align the skills of learners with the recruitment needs of current and future investors.

The working session concluded with a guided tour of the state-of-the-art facilities of the first integrated unit of GDIZ textile park, one of the largest in the world. This unit will process 20,000 tones of Benin's cotton fiber, from spinning to garment production. The factory will employ approximately 5,000 young Beninese individuals, making a significant contribution to job creation in Benin.

A NEW ERA FOR CROSS-BORDER TRADE: NIGERIA AND BENIN REMOVE IMPORT RESTRICTIONS ON 43 PRODUCTS

In an unprecedented initiative, Benin and Nigeria have jointly removed foreign exchange restrictions on 43 products, including food items, textiles, industrial goods, cosmetics, transportation, and construction materials.

These collaborative efforts mark a significant turning point in the relationship between these countries and herald a new era of economic cooperation.

The removal of these restrictions presents a significant opportunity for industries within GDIZ aiming to target the Nigerian market.

Indeed, GDIZ plays a crucial role in the transformation of several of the 43 products mentioned, thereby generating significant value for the sub-region. The removal of restrictions significantly amplifies economic opportunities associated with the production of these products: another reason to invest in Benin and target a global market of over 250.000.000 consumers.

Below is the list of the concerned products:

- Food Products: Rice, margarine, palm kernel, palm oilbased products, vegetable oils, meat and meat products, processed vegetables, processed plant products, poultry and poultry-based products, canned fish in sauce (Geisha)/sardines, toothpicks, glass and glassware items, kitchen utensils, tableware, gas bottles, tomato purchases/tomato concentrates.
- Textile: Woven fabrics, clothing.
- Construction Materials: Cement, cold-rolled steel sheets, galvanized steel sheets, wheelbarrows, pot heads, metal boxes and containers, enamel articles, steel drums,

steel pipes, deformed and non-deformed wire, iron bars, reinforcement bars, wire mesh, steel nails, steel fences and safety and razor poles, wood particle boards and panels, fiberboard panels and panels, plywood boards and panels, wooden doors, glazed and ceramic tiles.

- Industry/Transport: Aircraft/private jets.
- Cosmetics and Miscellaneous: Indian incense, soaps, and cosmetics.
